Subject: Family Unit Tracking Standard Operating Procedures

ERO Domestic Operations has developed a process for the 24 field offices to track Family Units (FAMU) released from the Southwest Border due to limited detention space.

U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has been encountering large numbers of FAMUs unlawfully in the United States along the Rio Grande Valley. Subsequent to arrest and processing of FAMUs by CBP, they are transferred to ICE custody. Due to the limited bed space, ERO is currently releasing FAMUs from custody and advising them to report to their local ERO field office within 15 days from the date of their release.

To track these FAMUs released from ICE custody, ERO HQ Domestic Operations has developed the attached process for implementation at all 24 field offices. The Law Enforcement Systems Analysis Division has created a FAMU docket for each field office (see attached).

Please submit the completed excel spreadsheet by the 7th of each month, with the first report due COB on July 7, 2014, to the ERO Operation Center mailbox as found in the Microsoft Global Address list.
