PATRICIA CESSPOOCH filed a document titled "Writ of Mandamus" with the Hualapai Tribal Court on June 15, 2012. The document is not a writ of mandamus, but appears to be a petition asking the Hualapai Court of Appeals to issue a writ of mandamus related to various motions filed on June 14, 2012 by Ms. Cesspooch in the case of *Sheri Yellowhawk v. Hualapai Election Board*, Tribal Court Case No.: 2012-CV-035 (*Yellowhawk* case). Ms. Cesspooch's pleading refers to a hearing from the *Yellowhawk* case held on May 15, 2012 and a resulting order dated May 25, 2012. Ms. Cesspooch appears to be contesting the validity of the May 25, 2012 order.

Ms. Cesspooch was not a party to the *Yellowhawk* case so does not have standing to file an appeal of the Tribal Court's order entered in that case. She also cannot file a petition for extraordinary relief related to that case since, again, she was not a party to that case. Ms. Cesspooch filed a motion to intervene in the case, but it was filed over two weeks after the Tribal Court entered its final order. Ms. Cesspooch's actions do not provide this Court with jurisdiction to hear her petition.

Based on the foregoing, and good cause appearing, this matter is hereby dismissed.
